Extended Care & 12-Step:

Once a client has graduated primary care, they will often need extended care treatment. Victory Bay offers a comprehensive extended care process that keeps its clients engaged in recovery long term. 12 step programs are strongly suggested as part of a client's extended care treatment track.

Co-Occuring Disorders:

Clients who enter into Victory Bay may have varying Behavioral Health issues in addition to their addiction. To address these issues, the Victory Bay clinical team is well versed and experienced in treating mental health and the underlying causes of addiction. Based on client requests or clinical recommendations, comprehensive psychiatric assessments by an ASAM Certified Psychiatrist are a part of our treatment process.

Addictions We Treat:

Heroin, Opiates, Alcohol, Cocaine, Crystal Meth, Marijuana, Benzos, Xanax, Percocet, Fentanyl, Oxycodone, and Fentanyl.

Trauma Programs:

At Victory Bay, our experienced clinical team aims to help its clients process this trauma that could be causing depression, anxiety, and eventual relapse.

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FULL CONTINUUM OF CARE

We have found that when someone is suffering from addiction, they are more likely to gain and maintain long-term sobriety if they have access to every level of care in the continuum. We provide a variety of options for entering treatment. These options include the Partial-Care, Intensive Outpatient, and Outpatient levels.

Detox: Victory Bay makes sure that each client is detoxed and has no medical complications before they enter into primary care.

Partial Care: Clients in Partial Care at Victory Bay will spend each morning and afternoon at the clinical center. These clients are often entering directly from a detox facility.

Intensive Outpatient (IOP): Clients in the IOP level of care will attend group therapy and receive one-on-one treatment at Victory Bay. These clients will report to primary therapists who will strongly recommend that they are active in their recovery and gain an understanding of what the recovery process consists of.

Outpatient (OP): Outpatient care is the least strict of the levels in the continuum. This level of care is reserved for Victory Bay clients who have been able to maintain some continued sobriety. They will be required to attend one or two groups a week and show up at the center for one on one therapy.

Structured Sober Living: Victory Bay works closely with sober living houses in the community. At Victory Bay we feel that close-knit sober communities can be helpful in creating more camaraderie among the Victory Bay clients. Clients in all levels of care will often stay at these structured sober living homes.

VICTORY BAY SERVICES

We understand that making the decision to enter a program is not an easy one. At Victory Bay we work to make this process as seamless as possible.

Admissions: Our experienced admissions team will use their extensive knowledge of insurance carriers to verify coverage benefits. This process is done free of charge. While an initial review of a potential client's benefits is necessary, the client's clinical needs are considered and evaluated above all else.

Travel Planning: Victory Bay is experienced at arranging and coordinating travel for its prospective clients. We can also arrange for a professional sober escort that will travel with clients if necessary. While Victory Bay travel arrangement and coordination is free of charge, there is a fee for sober escort services beyond the designated region. It should be noted that third party sober escort services are rarely necessary.

Continuing Care: Victory Bay will act as an advocate on behalf of its clients. If there are any issues during a client's treatment process, Victory Bay clinicians will take appropriate action and often reach out to the family and stakeholders of its clients. Following the completion of treatment, Victory Bay will maintain contact with each client on an intermittent basis to discuss his or her recovery. Should a client falter in their recovery, Victory Bay will attempt to help them reengage in the treatment process.


